### **Constitution Change**

This winter, the Board of Trustees voted to change the length of time an officer can hold the same office.

The elected term for the office of President, 1st Vice-President, and 2nd Vice-President shall be two (2) years, at which time the office of 1st Vice President and 2nd Vice President shall advance toward the office of President. The terms shall run from the day of the annual meeting to the next annual meeting at which an election is held for the position. No person shall hold the same position as President, 1st Vice-President or 2nd Vice-President for more than one (1) term at a time. At the conclusion of his/her term the outgoing President shall fill the position of Immediate Past President.

The elected term for the office of Secretary and the office of Treasurer shall be three (3) years, running from the day of the annual meeting to the next annual meeting at which time the election is held for the office of Secretary or the office of Treasurer. No person shall hold the same position as Secretary or Treasurer for more than two (2) terms consecutively.



## Norwalk Home and Business Show
